### Did you know?

- Local food pantries are dealing with issues of food price inflation, declining donations and increasing demand.
- Families are prioritizing which bills to pay, most often at the expense of their food. This phenomenon is known as “Heat or Eat” dilemma.
- A 16 oz. jar of change can add up to as much as \$25.00 which will buy an oven-stuffer roaster, a 5 lb. bag of potatoes, a dozen eggs, a loaf of bread, a gallon of milk, a box of cereal and a jar of peanut butter for a family in need.

Our philosophy is to educate and inspire others to turn their compassion into action by donating their spare change for basic needs.

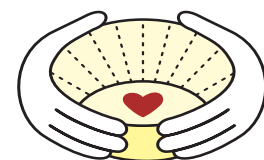
Everyone should have food to eat, fuel to stay warm, clothes to wear, educational opportunities, love and support.
